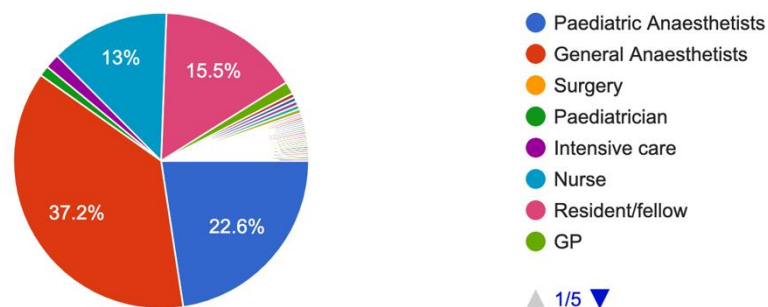

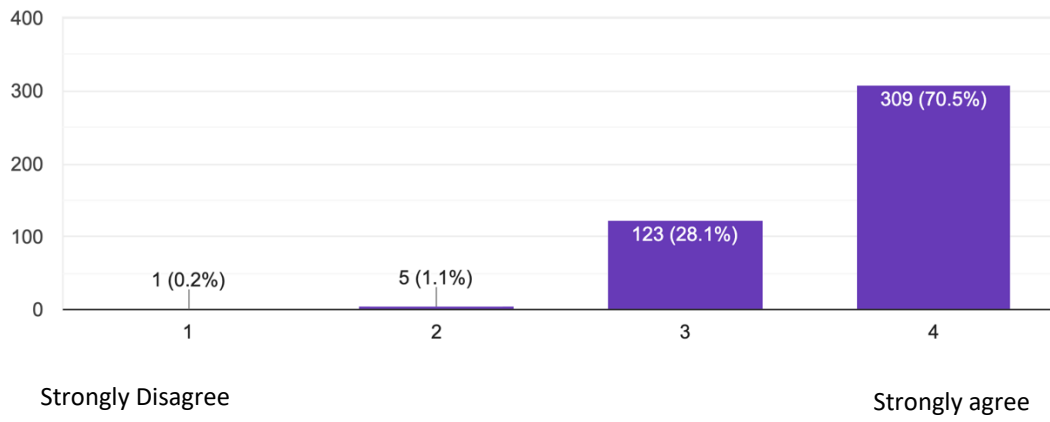

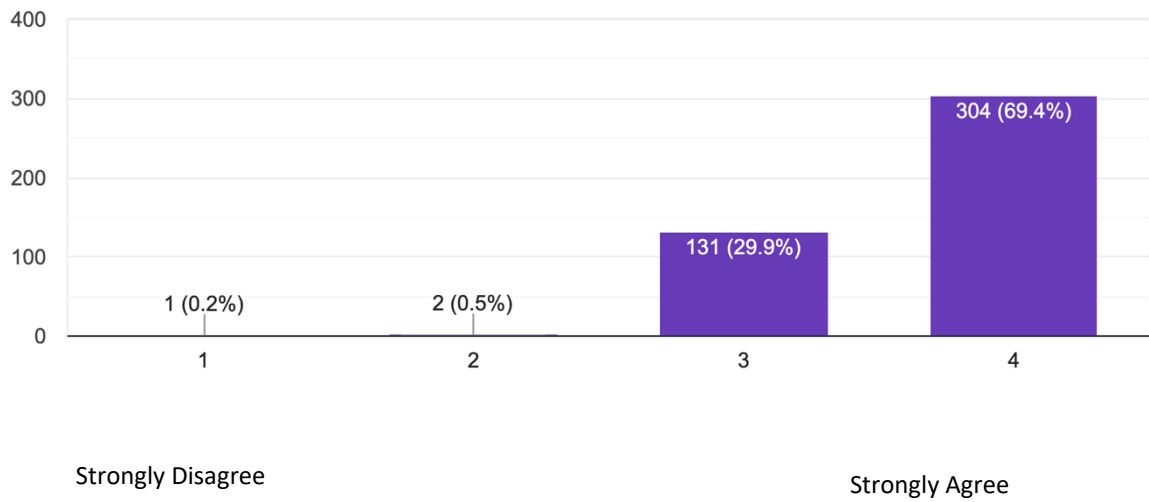

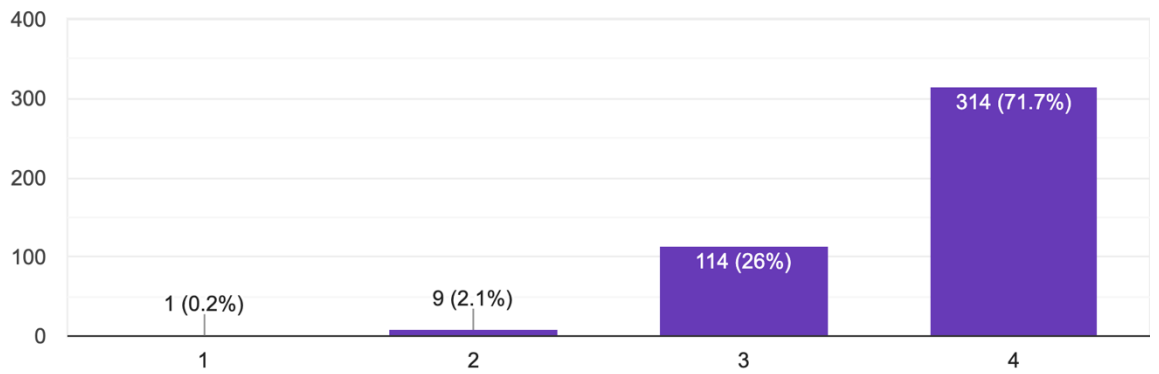

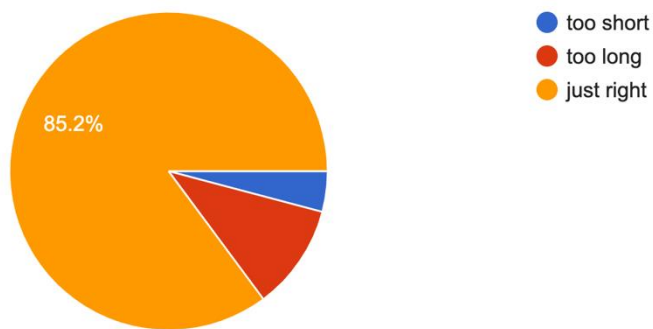


Strongly Disagree.

Strongly Agree

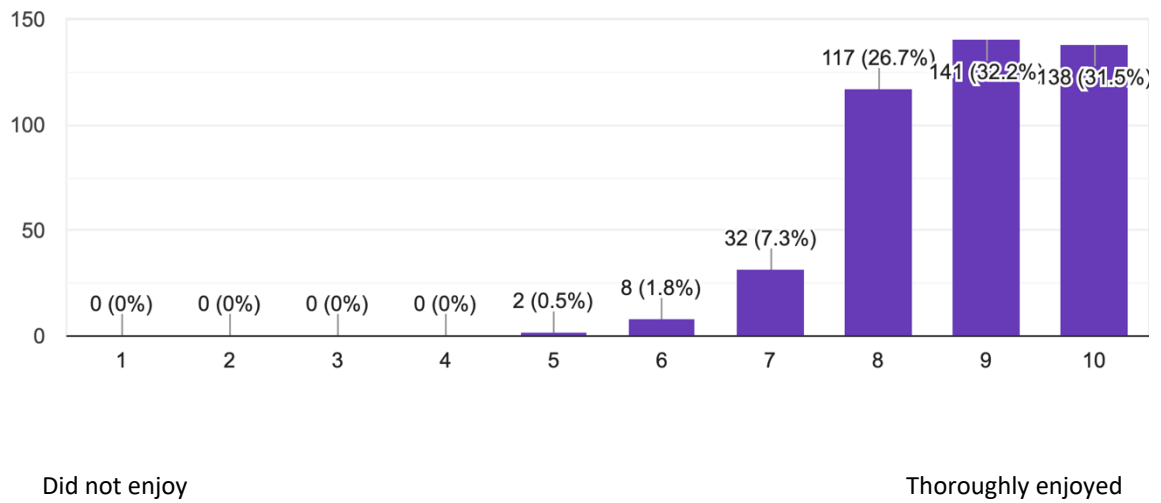
