



Background

- ENT surgeries are the commonest type of surgeries done in children. They are diverse and sharing of the airway makes it more challenging.
- There have been many advances and the use of newer technology in this field and we aimed to cover this.
- Since ENT endoscopy was assigned a separate webinar, we decided to cover other important aspects on this topic.
- Dr Rebecca Jacob (India) ASPA education committee, Dr Vibhavari Naik (India) - the webinar lead, and Dr Josephine Tan (Singapore) - the co-moderator and Dr Teddy Fabila (Philippines) – the webinar IT Support contributed ideas to organise this webinar as per ASPA requirements.





Webinar speakers

- We began with Dr Rufinah Teo describing the essential aspects of anaesthetizing children for cochlear implants. She also covered the anaesthetic concerns of these children for MRI.
- Dr Victor Alarva III discussed the surgical options for tonsilloadenoidectomy and its implications on postoperative pain. This topic was included as many anaesthesiologists are not aware of this.
- And finally, Dr Anita Shirley spoke on a very challenging clinical scenario – the retropharyngeal abscess. She highlighted the mistakes that should be avoided while anesthetizing these children.
- We had ample time for discussion in Q and A session and most queries of the audience were addressed.






The duration of the webinar was:








The talk by Dr Rufinah Teo on "Essentials in Anaesthesia for Cochlear Implant Surgeries" 222 responses








