

PAEDIATRIC PAIN FELLOW TRAINING PROGRAMME

The Paediatric Pain Fellow Training Programme is suitable for qualified and practicing trainees from countries which currently lack such services. Trainees may be from Anaesthesiology, Rheumatology, or Rehabilitation Medicine backgrounds, or may be from any other relevant field of training which requires exposure to the above-mentioned work.

Applicants whose departments have indicated a need for establishment of pain services will be allocated higher priority.

The applicant will have to include the particular field of interest (perioperative, complex, oncological/palliative, procedural, chronic pain) and any relevant information or questions from his/her department that may be answered in a completion report at the end of his/her time with us.

CRITERIA

- The applicant for the pediatric pain fellowship must be proficient in English language.
- He /She will have to meet the following criteria as stated by Singapore Medical Council under the "Framework for Postgraduate Training of Temporarily Registered Doctors from Schools not listed in the Schedule":
 1. Basic eligibility requirements for Temporary Registration
 2. Categories of Temporarily Registered Doctors for Postgraduate Training
